New Groups for 2018!!!

Mid Sussex MCC will be hosting some different classes for 2018 so please read this before completing your membership form.

Adult A – This group will now be named **Adult Open** and will be the only un-restricted adult class at Mid Sussex. Min age will remain at 17. Current Adult A members will have priority on retaining their 2017 race number in this class.

Adult B - This will now be a split group and will host two new classes, **VMX** and **Women's**. **VMX** is for riders aged 35 and over (you can enter at 34 providing you turn 35 during that year), **Women's** is for any adult (17 or over) female rider. This group will be run together but scored separately, there will be 40 spaces available in each race split over the two classes. As these two groups will be in the same race they will pick from the same pool of available numbers (1-99). Current Adult B members will have priority on retaining their 2017 race number in either of these classes where eligible. The maximum capacity of 60 members will remain, split over the two classes on demand. First come, first served.

Youth Open – This class will remain but will incorporate the Youth 125cc class riders. Both classes will race together, if we receive 10 or more membership applications for the 125cc class then they will be scored separately and there will be two championships. If we receive less than 10, the classes will race and be scored together as just the Youth Open class. (You must have the relevant category on your licence to compete in either class).

Associate Membership – Due to a large amount of people taking out a membership but not competing in 2017, we have introduced a new class of membership. New for 2018 is the Associate membership, this is simply a membership to the club but NOT in any group. This is for the people that need to be a member of an ACU club in order to obtain a code to apply for a race licence but it does not enter them into any of our groups leaving those valuable spaces for genuine racers that wish to compete for the whole championship. Associate membership is only £10 per person. Associate members can still book in to race any event but WILL NOT have the priority privilege of a full member but will take priority over visitors, they also won't score any championship points.

Membership Downgrading – In the instance of a group becoming full and closed to new members before the season starts, any member of that group that doesn't compete in the first three rounds of the championship (unless injured) will be downgraded to associate member status and will no longer hold a space in any group.
